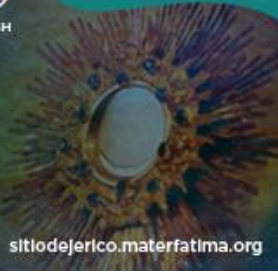

## INTENTIONS OF THE SIEGE OF JERICHO, MATER FATIMA FOR MY COUNTRY

**\* Only on the first day, the leader reads the special, the general and the communal intentions and gives a short time for everyone to ponder their personal intentions. All of these are placed on a table.**

### I. SPECIAL INTENTIONS.

### II. GENERAL INTENTIONS.

**Leader:** This Siege of Jericho is offered to ask God to bring down everything that is preventing His plan of salvation, through the Catholic Church, from being carried out throughout the world.

1. For the holiness of the Church, the Pope, Bishops, Priests, Deacons, Consecrated, Religious, Missionaries and Laity people.
2. For the respect for life, marriage and the protection of the family.
3. For peace and freedom in all people and nations.
4. For the conversion of sinners, reparation for our sins and the salvation of souls, especially those who are in danger of death.
5. For the eternal rest of souls in Purgatory, for the sick, the imprisoned and the persecuted, especially because of their faith.
6. For the end of all pandemics, for an increase in faith and the desire for conversion.
7. So that we all consecrate ourselves to the Holy Family of Nazareth: Jesus, Mary and Joseph.
8. For the worldwide increase in prayers of the Holy Rosary, Siege of Jericho, fasting, communion, and reparations on the First Fridays and Saturdays of the month.
9. For the Church militant that works for the Reign of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary and the devotion to Saint Joseph; including Mater Fatima.

### IV. PARTICULAR INTENTIONS. *There is a time of silence to meditate on them.*

**Leader:** Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary, we place all the intentions of this Siege of Jericho in Your hands, so that God's will may be fulfilled.

**All:** We ask You Lord and our Mother!

**\* NOTE: These prayers require prior confession or at least an act of perfect contrition and to remain in grace; read carefully the sections: *Explanation of the Siege of Jericho and Notes*, to understand its objectives, its origin and foundation in the Sacred Scriptures and Catechism, as well as the spiritual preparation that the person requires.**

**\* If the Eucharistic Adoration is “in situ” due to the extension of the prayers of the Siege of Jericho, it is suggested to pray briefly. If exposed live online, pray as you would normally do.**

**\* Only on the first day, the leader reads the special, general and communal intentions (page 4) if available, and it gives a short time for everyone to meditate on their personal intentions. It is recommended to have all participants sit around a table or if online individually.**

**\* Before starting, if you pray with more than 1 person, divide the reading assignments into equal parts, so each person knows which part they will read.**

**\*The leader should assign a reader to read the sections for each of the 8 WALLS. This will give greater participation order and understanding.**

## EUCHARIST ADORATION

† By the sign of the Holy Cross, † from our enemies, † deliver us Lord our God.

† In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

## READING OF INTENTIONS OF THE SIEGE OF JERICHO

**Leader:** Let us begin by asking God to help us tear down the walls of vices that affect our lives and our salvation.

### 1st WALL. - We are recognized as Human Persons Created in the Image of God

*\* The vices and virtues described are based on revelations from Our Lord to Saint Hildegard <sup>1</sup>*

**All:** I beg You Heavenly Father, that You destroy these vices in me and in all people with the virtues that revoke them:

- worldly love *with Divine Love* (1);
- worshipping the cult of death *with the Incredible Power of Worshiping God* (33);
- The vanity of following our will *with the humility of following God’s Will* (2), and grant us to persevere with Your grace. **Amen.**

## OFFERING

**All:** Heavenly Father, United with all of us who participate in this Siege of Jericho, I thank You for being a generous Father and for giving us faith in You, Your Son Jesus Christ and in Your Holy Spirit.

In the Name of Jesus, by His Most Holy Wounds and His Most Precious Blood <sup>2</sup>; through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary; of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, the



Guardian Angel of our nation <sup>3</sup>, of my guardian angel and all the angels of God; of Saint Joseph, most chaste husband of the Virgin Mary, of the saints and souls in Purgatory, **I OFFER YOU THESE PRAYERS**, to beg You to tear down "the walls" that are preventing Your Will from being fulfilled in me, in mine, in my country (     name it     ) and the whole world.

**I ASK YOU** that during and after these prayers, You give me the grace to see what You want to me to see, and hear what You want me to hear. Protect all those who are praying this Siege of Jericho, including our families, homes, and jobs. May the Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ seal all forms of communication from all evil distractions and foul play.

**All:** Come Holy Spirit, come through the powerful intercession of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Your Beloved Spouse. **(3 times)**.

### ACT OF CONTRITION

**All:** My Lord Jesus Christ, God and True Man, my Creator and Redeemer, because You are who You are and because I love You above all things, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee. I firmly intent with Your help, to never sin again, to separate myself from the occasions of sin, to confess and to fulfil the penance that was imposed on me. I offer my life, works, sufferings and sacrifices in reparation for my sins. I trust that, by Your kindness and infinite mercy, You will forgive me and give me the grace not to offend You again and to persevere in Your holy service until the end of my life. **Amen.**

### SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

**All:** I believe, my Jesus, that You are truly present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. I love You above all things and I ardently desire to receive You into my soul, but not being able to do it now sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart (**brief pause**). And as if I had already received You, I embrace You and join You completely. Lord, do not let me ever to separate from You. **Amen.**

### PRAYER FOR THE HOLY SOULS IN PURGATORY (by St. Gertrude the Great)

**All: Eternal Father**, I offer Thee the Most Precious Blood of Thy Divine Son Jesus, in union with the Masses said throughout the world today, for all the Holy Souls in Purgatory, for the sinners in the universal Church, those in my own home and within my family. **Amen**

**Leader:** Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord,

**All:** And let perpetual light shine upon them.

**Leader:** May they rest in peace.

**All:** Grant it in Your Divine Will. **(3 times)**



**Leader:** Most Holy Trinity, in your Divine Will, for the tortures suffered by our Lord Jesus Christ **IN THE WOUND OF HIS RIGHT HAND**, I ask You with faith and trust: **for our Holy Mother Catholic Church, the mystical body and bride of Jesus Christ; for my family, my nation and the whole world, especially for of us who are praying this Siege of Jericho.**

**2nd WALL. - Act of Forgiveness and Reparation to the Offences against God**

**All:** I beg You Heavenly Father, that You destroy these vices in me and in all people with the virtues that annul them:

- the hardness of heart and the lack of forgiveness *with the mercy of Jesus* (4,10);
- selfishness *with authentic generosity* (9);
- injustice *with justice* (23) y
- pride *with humility* (16), and grant us to persevere with your grace. **Amen.**

**PSALM 50, (51) MISERERE / O GOD, HAVE MERCY UPON ME! (Chorus: 1 and 2)**

- **C1:** Have mercy on me, O God, according to thy great mercy. And according to the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my iniquity.
- **C2:** Wash me yet more from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I know my iniquity, and my sin is always before me.
- **C1:** To thee only have I sinned, and have done evil before thee: that thou mayst be justified in thy words and mayst overcome when thou art judged. For behold I was conceived in iniquities; and in sins did my mother conceive me.
- **C2:** For behold thou hast loved truth: the uncertain and hidden things of thy wisdom thou hast made manifest to me. Thou shalt sprinkle me with hyssop, and I shall be cleansed: thou shalt wash me, and I shall be made whiter than snow.

- **C1:** To my hearing thou shalt give joy and gladness: and the bones that have been humbled shall rejoice. Turn away thy face from my sins and blot out all my iniquities.
- **C2:** Create a clean heart in me, O God: and renew a right spirit within my bowels. Cast me not away from thy face; and take not thy holy spirit from me.
- **C1:** Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation, and strengthen me with a perfect spirit. I will teach the unjust thy ways: and the wicked shall be converted to thee.
- **C2:** Deliver me from blood, O God, thou God of my salvation: and my tongue shall extol thy justice.
- **C1:** For if thou hadst desired sacrifice, I would indeed have given it: with burnt offerings thou wilt not be delighted. A sacrifice to God is an afflicted spirit: a contrite and humbled heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.
- **C2:** Deal favourably, O Lord, in thy good will with Sion; that the walls of Jerusalem may be built up. Then shalt thou accept the sacrifice of justice, oblations and whole burnt offerings: then shall they lay calves upon thy altar.

### REQUEST FOR PARDON <sup>5</sup>

**\*These sentences can be answered after each paragraph or just once at the end**

**Leader:** HOLY TRINITY, I feel pain for me, for the men and women of my family, my ancestors, my country, and of the whole world, who having been redeemed by You, have forgotten You; I humbly ask: Your forgiveness for our sins of thought, words, deeds and omissions; And for all of us who are praying this Siege of Jericho.

**All:** For not loving You Lord, above all things and for keeping silent, not supporting nor acting when You, or something of Yours is being offended; for having fallen into beliefs contrary to You; for not making an effort to learn the Catholic Faith better, living it mediocly, being ashamed, or for denying it. **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (1st Commandment)

- For the times that I have not seen or appreciated the good things that You give me, and for denying The Cross that You allowed for the salvation of my soul. **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (1st Commandment)
- For not preaching the Gospel, Baptism, Repentance, Confession and Forgiveness of Sins; for not looking to make disciples of all nations, and not recognizing that only He is the Way, the Truth and the Life, and that no one goes to the Father if it is not through The Son (Jn 14: 6). **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (1st Commandment Mk 16: 15-16; Mt. 28: 18-20; Lk. 24: 45-48)
- For the times I have taken Your Name in vain; for not responding properly to the vocation to which you have called me, and failing to fulfil my duty. **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (2nd Commandment)
- For the times I have not attended Mass on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation, for receiving the Holy Eucharist in serious sin or unworthily; for offences against the Virgin Mary and holy persons, places or things; for paganizing Christian holidays and celebrating pagan holidays, such as Halloween; for misusing the Sacraments and Sacramentals<sup>6</sup>, for falling into simony<sup>7</sup>

and for not fulfilling the Six Commandments of the Church<sup>8</sup>. **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (3rd Commandment)

- For all the times that I do not practice the spiritual and corporal works of mercy<sup>9</sup>, and for the times that I have not loved or respected my parents, my spouse, my children and my neighbour **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (4th Commandment)
- For not always defending the Catholic Faith, life, marriage, procreation, family, purity, liberty and peace according to Your Will; for the times I have neglected our family, body, health and soul, or that we have indulged vices; and for the times that I have induced others to sin, I have been accomplice of sin or have been a cause of scandal, and for dressing indecently, especially in your Temples. **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (5th Commandment)
- For the times I have allowed impure acts and thoughts. **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (6th and 9th Commandment)
- For the times I have stolen, I have wasted time, money, food and words; and I have coveted other people's goods. **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (7th and 10th Commandment)
- For the times I have lied, deceived, have not defended the truth and have given false testimony. **Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** (8th Commandment)
- And for everything that I failed to name that offends You, so that I recognize it as a sin, confess it and made reparations for it; especially, for not allowing Your Holy Spirit to guide me.

**Leader: For all this, Forgive me, Lord, Forgive me!** I welcome Your Infinite Mercy, begging You to receive me as the Prodigal Son, who, repentant, returns to His Father (Lk 15, 11-32). Send Your Holy Spirit upon us and fill us with its bond of Love between the Father and the Son to give to others, so that we no longer offend You.

**All: Amen.**

*(Kneeling or standing)* REPARATION PRAYER GIVEN AT FATIMA<sup>10</sup>

- **All:** My God! I believe, I adore, I hope and I love Thee. I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love Thee. **(3 times)**.<sup>11</sup>
- Most Holy Trinity- Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the Most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for outrages, sacrileges and indifference whereby He is offended. And through the infinite merits of His Most Sacred Heart and of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of Thee the conversion of poor sinners.<sup>12</sup>
- O Holy Trinity, I adore You. My God, I love You in the Blessed Sacrament.<sup>13</sup>

O Jesus, it is for Your love, for the conversion of sinners and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary<sup>14</sup>

**Leader:** Jesus, Meek and Humble of Heart...

**All:** Make my Heart like Unto Thine **(3 times)**.



**Leader:** Most Holy Trinity, in Your Divine Will, for the tortures suffered by our Lord Jesus Christ **IN THE WOUND OF HIS LEFT HAND**, I ask You with faith and trust: for **the Holy Mother Catholic Church, mystical body and bride of Jesus Christ; for my family, my nation and the whole world, especially for those who are praying this Siege of Jericho.**

**All:** I beg you Heavenly Father, that You destroy these vices in me and in all people with the virtues that revoke them:

- worldly desires *with detachment from the world*(29);
- disobeying You *with obeying You* (19);
- inconstancy in my vocation *with the constant desire to follow You* (26); and
- forgetfulness of God and concerns for earthly goods *with full awareness of God's presence and the eagerness to obtain spiritual goods* (25, 27), and grant us to persevere with Your Grace. **Amen.**

#### HYMN "VENI CREATOR SPIRITUS" (Chorus: 1 and 2)

**All:** Come, Holy Spirit, Creator blest, and in our souls take up Thy rest; come with Thy grace and heavenly aid to fill the hearts with Thou hast made...

- **C1:** O comforter, to Thee we cry, O heavenly gift of God Most High, O fount of life and fire of love, and sweet anointing from above.
- **C2:** Thou in Thy sevenfold gifts are known; Thou, finger of God's hand we own; Thou, promise of the Father, Thou Who dost the tongue with power imbue.



- **C1:** Kindle our sense from above, and make our hearts overflow with love; with patience firm and virtue high the weakness of our flesh supply.
- **C2:** Far from us drive the foe we dread, and grant us Thy peace instead; so shall we not, with Thee for guide, turn from the path of life aside.
  
- **C1:** O may Thy grace on us bestow the Father and the Son to know; and Thee, through endless times confessed, of both the eternal Spirit blest.
  
- **C2:** Now to the Father and the Son, Who rose from death, be glory given, with Thou, O Holy Comforter, henceforth by all in earth and heaven. **Amen.**

#### OFFERING TO THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

**All:** Blessed Virgin Mary, Queen and Mother of Families; Intercessor, Mediator and our Advocate. We offer You this **SIEGE OF JERICHO AND ROSARY**, and we ask You to join us in praying in union with the Guardian Angel of our nation and the entire Celestial Court, in reparation for our sins, sacrileges and offences; those of who blaspheme against the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Your Immaculate Heart; for the Conversion and Salvation of all souls; for the increase of the Catholic Faith, Peace, Life, Marriage and Family in the Will of God; by the Pope, the Priests, and all who defend and promote Catholic values.

Mother, You are our hope and in You, we trust. Teach us to pray with a humble heart, to live with joy, in unity and love, to recover Trust, Justice and Peace and give a true testimony of being Your children. **Amen**

#### PRAYER TO SAINT JOSEPH BY POPE LEO XIII<sup>15</sup>

**All:** To thee, O Blessed Joseph, we fly in our tribulation and after imploring the help of thy holy Spouse, with confidence we ask also for thy intercession. By the affection which united thee to the Immaculate Virgin Mother of God, and by the paternal love with which thou didst embrace the Child Jesus, we beseech thee to look kindly upon the inheritance which Jesus Christ acquired by His Precious Blood, and with thy powerful aid to help us in our needs.

Protect, most careful guardian of the Holy Family, the chosen people of Jesus Christ. Keep us, loving father, from all pestilence of error and corruption. From thy place in heaven be thou mercifully with us, most powerful protector, in this warfare with the powers of darkness and, as thou didst once rescue the Child Jesus from imminent danger of death, so now defend the Holy Church of God from the snares of the enemy and from all adversity. Guard each of us by thy constant patronage, so that, sustained by thy example and help, we may live a holy life, die a holy death, and obtain the everlasting happiness of heaven. Amen



## PRAYER TO THE GUARDIAN ANGEL (by Father Pio of Pietrelcina)

## EXPLAINING THE SIEGE OF JERICHO (SJ)

### BEFORE STARTING

- **Make a good confession.**
- **LET US TRUST THAT LOVE, HUMILITY, PRAYER AND FASTING**, given to God through the Most Holy Virgin Mary, is a pleasing offering and according to His Divine Will and greater benefit of the salvation of souls, He will guide history for the soon to come. Triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary that the world today needs so much.
  - **Love conquers all**, Hymn of Charity of Saint Paul. Without love, not even the most heroic deeds are worth before God, love will never pass, etc. **(1<sup>a</sup> Cor 13)**
  - **Sincere humility moves God**. Like when Jehoshaphat and the people of Israel prostrated themselves asking God to save them in their battle against the Ammonites and Moabites: "Do not be afraid or frightened before this great crowd; for this war is not yours but Yahweh's... You will not have to fight in this place, but will stand and see Yahweh's salvation upon you" **(2 Cr 20)**
  - **Jesus teaches that with prayer and fasting one defeats evil**. "Once inside the house, his disciples asked him privately: "Why couldn't we expel that spirit?" And he answered them: "This class of demons cannot be cast out except through prayer and fasting" **(Mc 9, 28-29)**
  - **Constant prayer is heard by God**, an example is when Moses and the people of Israel fight against the Amalekites, Moses did not stop praying with his hands up **(Ex 17, 8-15)**
- If this is your first time praying the Siege of Jericho prayer, **it is very important to read this explanation**; to understand the objectives and origin of this type of prayer, **and above all the spiritual preparation it requires** for greater spiritual fruit.
- **Anyone baptized and in a state of grace can participate in Mater Fatima Siege of Jericho (SJ) and/or direct it**. All sentences have been carefully checked:
  - The renunciation and rejection of the evil caused by other people on us, our families and nations, can be done personally, and for our family, our nation and the world, exercising the grace that Baptism confers on us that configures us in Christ: in priests (common priesthood different from the sacrament of holy orders), prophets and kings **(1 Pe. 2:4-5,9 Catholic Catechism #783-786)**
  - The personal renunciation and rejection of evil, declares our intention to strive to avoid sinning and helps to perform a better penance to repair the damage caused by our sins, which God fully forgives us in sacramental confession **(Catholic Catechism #1427-1429 conversions; #1459-1460 penance)**.
  - **The prayer where God is asked to free us from all evil is in a language that both priests and lay people can use**, since it is in a **derogatory sense** or of intense prayer to God, that is, so that it is He who frees us from evil, avoiding

ordering the enemy in the first person, which is the **imbricative language** reserved for bishops and priests. (Card. Joseph Ratzinger 29-Sep-1985)

- **If someone has an impediment to confess or make an act of perfect contrition, it is recommended that they do not say these prayers**, but they can offer Masses, Rosaries, Fasts,
- Sacrifices and Visits to the Blessed Sacrament so that God helps him to resolve his impediment to confession and amendment, and so that the SJ bears fruit
- **To make the act of contrition perfect**, see below the section **“when there is no possibility of confession and sacramental communion”**.
- **You can pray in a group or individually**. Ideally, it is recommended to pray it in a temple before the Blessed Sacrament or do it at home before a Blessed Crucifix and Candle or in front of the Blessed Sacrament on TV or the Internet.
- Originally it consisted of praying the Rosary without interruption before the Blessed Sacrament for 7 full days, but over time it has been reformed. It can be done with different prayers, the important thing is to do it with faith from the heart, in a true dialogue with our Lord.
- The Siege of Jericho must be prayed for 7 consecutive days without skipping a day. Cutting it lowers the spiritual result. Perseverance is invited despite fatigue and doubts that may arise. *Read 2 Timothy ;, 12b. “Because I know in whom I have my trust”*
- These prayers of the Siege of Jericho (SJ) Mater Fátima with the Rosary integrated, last approximately 1:15 mins, plus the time of the procession that you decide to do.
- **It is recommended to pray the SJ with the Rosary integrated**, keeping us under the protection of the Virgin Mary, but if occasionally one day there is little time available, the prayers of the Rosary can be separated (marked in thick boxes in this manual), and pray them at another time; **with the condition of praying the Rosary afterwards, on the same day as the prayers of the Siege of Jericho** The prayers of SJ without the Rosary last approximately 55 minutes, plus the procession that you decide to do.

#### FOUNDATIONS FOR THE SIEGE OF JERICHO, MATER FATIMA

- **The first foundation is the Siege of Jericho reported in the book of Joshua 6, 1-20**, where God tells Joshua that he will give him the City of Jericho, strongly walled. To do this, he instructs him to go around it with the priests carrying the Ark of the Covenant and their warriors behind it, once a day for 6 days and on the 7th day they go around it 7 times, and at the end, with a war cry, God would bring down the walls. So, Joshua and the Israelites did, God miraculously brought down the walls, and they took the city.
- **The second foundation** is the action of intercession that Our Lord Jesus Christ blesses in the passage of **Lk. 5:17-26 on the Healing of a Paralyzed**. Where the evangelist recounts that four men carried a paralytic; and to present him to Jesus, they carried him to the roof, they removed the shingles and lowered him at the feet of the Lord. **Jesus, seeing the faith of these men, said to him: “my friend your sins are forgiven you,” “get up and walk”;**

**he was healed and walked.** How many spiritual paralytics do we know today that need our help to be carried to our Lord, removing the shingles or obstacles that prevent them from approaching Him to heal the paralysis in them, and they might have the opportunity, with their free will, to rectify their evil path and save themselves and also pass it on to all those who are affected by their wrongdoings?

- **The third foundation is based on the Prayer of the Siege of Jericho that was first organized in Poland between 1978 and 1979** asking God for his intervention to tear down the spiritual and physical walls that prevented Pope John Paul II from visiting his native country. At that time, the Siege of Jericho consisted of 7 days of Adoration to the Most Blessed Sacrament, praying the Rosary 24 hours a day in shifts. At the end of the 7 days, the Polish authorities miraculously authorized the Pope's visit. This was the beginning of the Divine action and intercession of the Virgin Mary over Poland, the former Soviet Union and other countries, which were miraculously liberated from the Communist Atheist regime from 1979 to 1991.
- **The fourth foundation of the Siege of Jericho Mater Fatima are the prayers of spiritual battle with ecclesiastical permission** used in a format of Siege of Jericho by the Archdiocese of Guadalajara, Mexico, approved on Nov-9-2015. In fact, as an additional historical reference, the first prayers of Siege of Jericho in Mexico were approved by Monsignor Juan José Posadas Ocampo, Archbishop of Guadalajara, Mexico, in 1989.
- **The fifth foundation is the integration of the Holy Rosary and the prayers given in Fatima in 1917, approved by the Church** as the backbone of spiritual battle prayers.
- **The sixth foundation on which this Siege of Jericho is based are prayers of forgiveness, renunciation and rejection, based on Sacred Scripture and on the Catechism of the Catholic Church.**
- **The seventh foundation is the previous spiritual preparation sought for each Siege of Jericho Mater Fatima.**
- **The eighth foundation is to renew our baptismal promises.** Take advantage of doing it after the detailed renunciation and rejection of evil and sin in the Siege of Jericho. This frequent practice combats evil in the world, according to Saint Louis Marie Grignion de Montfort (TVDVM # 126-131).

#### OBJECTIVES FOR THE SIEGE OF JERICHO, MATER FATIMA PRAYERS

- **Its objective is to ask God to break down the physical and/or spiritual "walls" caused by evil and sin, and that do not allow a situation to be resolved** in a person, a family, a community, town, or nation, due to the fact that these "walls" prevent the Grace of God from penetrating and resolving such a situation.
- It is a spiritual battle asking God through the intercession of the Most Blessed Virgin, to tear down the spiritual, intellectual and physical walls
  - Of sins against the 1st Commandment, such as idolatry, magic, spiritism, and new practices that God detests (Dt. 18:9-14, Leviticus 17 through 20, pontifical document Jesus Christ Bearer of the Water of Life) that may have been committed by the

affected person, by a family member, or by some stranger, but they are affecting the life of that person.

- As well as sins against the rest of God's 10 Commandments, (Dt 5:6-21) that also affect us.
- From situations caused by unknown people or actions, trusting that God can help us eliminate them, for there is nothing impossible for Him.

## SPIRITUAL PREPARATION FOR THE SIEGE OF JERICHO

**Before starting the SJ it indispensable to be in God's Grace.** Be confessed and have received communion. When there is any impediment to this, see later the section "**when there is no possibility of confession and sacramental communion**"

- **It is also important to confess any lack of forgiveness, decide to forgive and do so.** Do not forget to fix these situations, to be truly in grace for our prayer to bear fruit (**Mark 11, 25-26; Luke 17: 3-4; Matthew 5: 22-26**), as well as not to give room to the enemy in our hearts (**Ephesians 4:26-27**). **Forgiveness is a decision and when it is difficult, we must ask God for the grace to heal our hearts and regain peace. If necessary, ask for help from a confessor or spiritual guide.**
- **Prior to the Siege of Jericho (1 to 7 days before), it is recommended to:**
  - **Pray the Rosary, make a good Confession, attend Holy Mass and receive Holy Communion** if possible every day, or at least the days of precept and the other days make a Spiritual Communion.
  - **Fast one day**, ideally on bread and water during the 3 meals; he/she who has just started practicing it, can substitute only 1 of the 3 meals with bread and water.
  - **Anyone who cannot do this type of fasting can offer in prayer for one or more days, not eat a food of his predilection** (e.g. coffee, soft drink, some dish, bread or dessert). *"For even if you were to give only a pin, as long as you give it with all your heart, it would be enough for Jesus, who only attends to good will."* (*Treatise of True devotion to the Virgin Mary, by St. Louis Marie Grignon de Montfort #232*).
  - **Anyone who has any illness or is pregnant should not take any risk, we recommend they should take a doctor's opinion before fasting.**

- **During the Siege of Jericho (the 7 days) for spiritual strengthening it is suggested** in addition to praying daily the SJ, to Adore the Most Blessed Sacrament for a few minutes (in person or spiritually) and praying another Rosary at the time that each person is able to.
- **After completing the Siege of Jericho (about 7 days) as a thanksgiving to God, adoration to the Most Holy Sacrament for a few minutes is suggested** (in person or spiritually) and to pray a Rosary at any time you are able to.
- **In periods of time when the Siege of Jericho is not being prayed, it is highly recommended to continue praying the daily Rosary permanently.** Frequent reception of the Holy Eucharist and the daily recitation of the Holy Rosary are the most powerful spiritual weapons to keep our souls and families protected from evil, vigilant and faithful to God and to the Holy Eucharist.

#### WHEN THERE IS NO POSSIBILITY OF CONFESSION NOR SACRAMENTAL COMMUNION

The Apostolic Penitentiary recognizes that there are special situations that fall within the heading of "cases of grave need", cited in canon 961, § 2 of the Code of Canon Law, where it is not possible to confess in person to a priest.

"When the faithful finds himself in the painful impossibility of receiving sacramental absolution, it should be remembered that the act of perfect contrition is to express a sincere request for forgiveness from God that must be accompanied by the firm purpose of fulfilling the sacramental confession as soon as possible. He/she obtains forgiveness of sins, even mortals (cf. Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 1451 and 1452)."

Steps for the perfect act of contrition:

1. **Make a good written examination of conscience and keep it.** This same examination of conscience must be verbally confessed to a priest as soon as the grave situation preventing confession is over.
2. **True pain of sins, for having offended God,** and to a degree that He sees our repentance.
3. **Purpose of amendment.** Making the resolution of not committing those sins again.
4. **Confession by mouth. This step will remain pending until it can be done in front of a priest. If this step does not happen as soon as the faithful is able to do it, the act of perfect contrition will be invalid,** because it means that we really had no pain from those sins, to impel us to seek prompt verbal confession at all costs, and thus gain sacramental forgiveness.
5. **Fulfill the penance.** This step will be completed at the time the priest imposes the penance when the verbal confession is made, at the end of the situation of grave impossibility of confession in which he/she found him/herself.

## HOW THE SIEGE OF JERICHO IS MADE

### PREPARATION OF THE INTENTIONS FOR THE SIEGE OF JERICHO

1. Print Mater Fatima's general Intentions (see at the end of the prayers)
2. If prayed in a parish or a prayer group, presided by a Priest or lay leader, **the communal intentions** should be written on a separate sheet of paper.
3. In addition, every faithful writes his/her **particular intentions** on another sheet of paper. If the faithful will pray all 7 days at the same place with the same group, he/she could leave their personal written intentions at the designated place with the general intentions, otherwise, he/she must keep it the whole time to take it with him/her to the other places of prayer each day.

### WHEN IT IS PRESIDED BY A PRIEST IN A PARISH

The priest exposes the MOST HOLY SACRAMENT OF THE ALTAR and on a designated table, the sheets of the General and Communal Intentions of the Siege of Jericho are placed in a box or basket (points 1 and 2 above).

The faithful who participate may carry with them their particular intentions sheets; or they may leave them with the general and community intentions sheets.

**WHEN IT IS PRAYED AT HOME.** Place on a table a BLESSED CRUCIFIX (you can add Blessed Images of Jesus and Our Lady) and a Blessed Candle to be lit during the prayer, **the general intentions sheet and the particular intentions sheet for the Siege of Jericho** must be placed at the foot of the Crucifix.

### RECOMMENDATIONS ON HOW TO PRAY THE SIEGE OF JERICHO

- **All the prayers of the Siege of Jericho must be prayed in an audible voice**, so that the evil one hears that we renounce sin and reject him, asking God that with his Infinite Power, He may draw all evil out of our lives so that He is the only king in our hearts and our existence.
- **Ideally, it is prayed before the Most Blessed Sacrament Exposed.** As a Chapel of Perpetual Adoration is normally a place of silence, it might not be the most appropriate

place to pray the Siege of Jericho, unless it is allowed to pray it aloud in that chapel at certain times of the day.

- **In general, the prayers of the Siege of Jericho Site can be prayed kneeling or seated.** Furthermore, the prayers given in Fatima could even be prayed prostrating ourselves (kneeling and with the forehead on the ground), as the Angel of Portugal taught the little seer shepherds.
- **The prayers of renunciation and rejection are suggested to be prayed in a standing position,** for we seek to recover our dignity as children of God through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, the Angels and the Saints; these are prayers of spiritual combat in which we plead to God that He expels the evil that we have allowed into our lives due to our sins or that for some other reason, it is affecting us.

### OPTIONAL PHYSICAL LAPS

- At the end of the daily prayers, we plea to God to tear down the walls of the city of Jericho (represented by the printed intention sheets), and if desired, the person can walk around the table where the intentions were placed, recreating the siege described in Joshua 6, 1-20.
- Go around where the intention sheets were placed (as if it were the city of Jericho), and the person who presides, along with the attendees, walk in laps without talking, and if preferred, ringing bells (simulating the trumpets described in the Bible). The route of each lap can be as short or long as desired: around the table of intentions, inside the house or around the place where it was prayed.
- **From the 1st to the 6th day, the procession consists of doing 1 lap and on the 7th day of doing 7 laps.**
- **From day 1st to day 6th,** with or without the physical lap, with great faith and in silence, we plea to God to collapse “the walls” that are affecting us, represented by the intention read on Day 1 for the Siege of Jericho. (FINAL PRAYERS FOR EVERY DAY are prayed).
- **On the 7th day,** with or without the 7 physical lap as decided, according to how it is recounted in the Holy Bible, we implore 7 times to God to tear down the walls of Jericho (sheets with intentions).  
*At the end, with GREAT ENTHUSIASM AND JOY we pray "GLORY TO GOD..." prayer followed by the FINAL PRAYERS FOR EVERY DAY, concluding the 7 days of prayer. The sheets of intentions must be torn up and thrown in the garbage or burned, trusting that GOD will take care of our problems.*
- **IF THE SJ IS DONE AT A CHURCH, and the priest in charge agrees to it,** he can do a procession with the Most Blessed Sacrament (simulating the Arc of the Covenant mentioned in Joshua’s passage) going around the intention sheets physically, either, only around the table where they were placed, or inside or outside the temple, as agreed.
- **IF THE SJ IS DONE AT HOME,** the procession is done with the BLESSED CRUXIFIX (simulating the Arc of the Covenant mentioned in Joshua’s passage).

<sup>1</sup> The Most Holy Trinity is asked to send us the angelic choir of the Virtues so that, in union with our prayer, they may help us to combat the vices that tempt us. Next, the 35 vices are listed with the 35 virtues that defeat them, according to the visions that Our Lord Jesus Christ gave to Saint Hildegard of Bingen and that she relates in her work Liber Vitae Meritorum (Book of the Merits of Life), a work she wrote between the year 1158 and 1163

1. *The vice of worldly love that seeks not to grow old and enjoy all the delight of the world without wanting to know of eternal life, is combated with the virtue of Divine Love that accepts life in the world, but rejects what harms its eternal life..*
2. *The petulance or insolent vanity of only doing one's own will over that of God is combated with the virtue of Discipline based on the joyful fulfilment of Divine Justice..*
3. *The vain fun in inconvenient (indecent) shows to the eyes and the flesh, is fought with the virtue of Modesty in the honesty of customs (modesty, modesty or decency).*
4. *Hardness of heart or lack of benevolence is combated with the virtue of Mercy that instils goodness.*
5. *he in apathy or cowardly laziness (false human respect) who does not defend the truth by trusting more in the weakness of the flesh than in the divine strength, is fought with the virtue of the Divine Victory of fighting for truth and justice with the Word of God.*
6. *The anger or rage that tramples and kills everything that offends him is fought with the virtue of Patience that is always calm and just, that no one tramples and no one condemns it.*
7. *The foolish joy that irrationally and blindly believes to have full life in the flesh, is combated with the Desire of God who sees that worldly life withers, and preserves divine harmony and angelic and spiritual joy.*
8. *The gluttony of food and wine that induces blasphemy, mockery and inadequate fasting when it barely lets live and is followed by voracious gluttony, is combated with the virtue of Abstinence, temperance or self-control in eating and drinking.*
9. *The roughness or bitterness against acts of courage and holiness (selfishness), and that comes from not thanking God for everything He gives us is fought with the Authentic Generosity that pours out grace, joy, mercy and consolation.*
10. *The ungodliness or lack of forgiveness that returns all offense with aggressiveness, cruelty, cheating and evil for one's own benefit and believing itself to be just, is fought with the virtue of Piety that is enjoyed in justice and discretion.*
11. *Falsehood, hypocrisy or insincerity that seeks positions, favours, wealth and acceptance, is fought with the virtue of Truth in honour, beatitude and honesty in God..*
12. *The desire for strife that with words and deception annoys and offends to destroy good purposes and tranquillity, is fought with the virtue of Peace that heals offenses and does not esteem unjust wars or incline to eternal dispute.*
13. *The unhappiness that only brings us sorrows for not trusting or asking God for his grace is combated with the virtue of Happiness that seeks, invokes, trusts and waits in God.*
14. *Immoderation in food, amusement, laughter, pleasure and words of convenience is combated with the virtue of Discretion in honest customs that make us understand and desire the secrets of God.*
15. *The perdition of souls who reject God and prey upon them is fought with the virtue of the Salvation of Souls that with faith in Baptism and the Holy Eucharist, anoints the simple and innocent with the Holy Spirit for battle.*

16. *Pride that seeks that no one surpasses or resembles it and steals the reward of holiness from those who allow themselves to boast for their good deeds and lose discernment, is fought with the virtue of Humility that illuminates darkness.*
17. *Envy that hates the good works of God in others and desires evil is fought with the virtue of the Charity of holy works, and even when the Son of God blots out man's sins with his robe, heals his wounds.*
18. *The vainglory that seeks earthly honour and not the grace of God, is fought with the virtue of the Fear of God that avoids sin and seeks good things to become God's dwelling place.*
19. *Disobedience to God, which exalts and obstinates man in his science and evil, even of diabolical arts, is fought with the Obedience of fulfilling only the will of God by accepting that only through Him one exists and grows.*
20. *The unbelief that knows that God exists and refuses to venerate Him worthily, is fought with the virtue of Faith that leads to praise to God, desire to follow His commandments and all that belongs to Him.*
21. *The despair that brings terror, sadness and discomfort for not trusting in God and makes one believe oneself lost before being judged, is fought with the virtue of Hope in God, who does not leave good works unrewarded.*
22. *The lust that thinks that if the flesh were not pleasing to God it would not have done so, and justifies the depravity of the flesh, is fought with Chastity that respects the just and natural conception of the flesh established by God*
23. *The injustice that seeks to take advantage of the creatures tramples them and refuses to give them what corresponds to them, is fought with the virtue of Justice that cares with honour to the creatures and gives them joy by giving them what touches them.*
24. *The acedia or spiritual laziness of working for the salvation of the soul, is fought with the virtue of the Fortress that works and sighs for all the good things of God.*
25. *The forgetfulness of God that making us believe that He ignores us is better to do our will, is fought with Holiness that recognizing that God gives everything, invokes it, asks for it and serves it with maximum devotion.*
26. *The inconstancy that deceives and seeks novelties, neglecting the most important earthly and spiritual actions, is fought with Constancy that always maintains good and honest ways.*
27. *The concern for earthly things caused by the staunch activity to the temporal and obsolete without seeking God, is combated by the virtue of the Celestial Desire that places ephemeral things after the celestial and eternal.*
28. *Stubbornness that does not see good or piety, but hardens against God, is fought with the virtue of Repentance against hardness and that sees that God wants to mercifully tear us away from evil spirits.*
29. *The worldly desire for wealth, honour and beauty without desiring heaven is fought with the virtue of the Contempt of the World that seeks the essential, does not yield to sin and seeks heaven with all its heart.*
30. *Discord does not want peace, it divides and destroys what God has done; it is fought with the virtue of Concord that unites in one heart, one soul and goods in common in God from whom everything derives and disposes rightly.*
31. *Fatuity that conceitedly insults, flatters or denigrates others is fought with the virtue of Respect that is pleased in all things created by God and harms no one.*
32. *The frivolity that, without loving God, by arrogance shows itself venerable and devout, is combated with the virtue of Prudent Stability that sets its sights on God, on what He says and likes and obtains his kiss and his embrace.*
33. *The curse that seeks in creatures and hidden arts what is wanted, venerating the demonic and abandoning God, is fought with the virtue of the True Worship of God in which only He is always worshiped and not His works.*

34. *The greed that monopolizes things, killing even for them in total oblivion of God, is fought with the virtue of the Total Detachment of God's goods sufficient for all..*

35. *The sadness of suffering for existence, sorrow, anxiety and laziness, without loving oneself or others for not trusting God, is fought with the Heavenly Joy that rejects the bitterness of sorrow and adheres to God with faith and joy.*

simultaneously fall on their knees and say this beautiful prayer: “O Most Holy Trinity, I adore You. My God, my God, I love You in the Blessed Sacrament”.

El The set of beliefs in false gods is called paganism, and a branch very driven by the new age is pantheism that worships the universe, the earth and nature, and does not recognize that they are works created by God.

On the other hand, there are beliefs that distort the truth in Jesus Christ and the Holy Trinity, such as Gnosticism that believes in salvation through an occult and esoteric knowledge of God (examples are theosophy and Rosicrucianism); the Pelagianism that believes in the supposed salvation by personal merits without the need of the grace of God; the modernism that promotes substituting the two-thousand-year-old Catholic tradition for new thoughts, the relativism that instills the belief that everyone has their own valid truth to save themselves; and the new age, which is very dangerous, subtly put promotes a syncretism (mixture of contrary beliefs), which encourages the belief in a "universal consciousness", "cosmic energy", "a great architect" or "a false god" ethereal, vague, indefinite, nebulous, which is not the true God of the Catholic Church.

There are also Christian beliefs that are separated from the Catholic Doctrine founded by Jesus Christ, some examples are Protestantism, Jehovah's Witnesses, Mormons, etc., which distort the truths of Baptism, the Holy Eucharist, Confession, the

---

Priestly Order, the Papal authority, the role of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the plan of salvation willed by God, likewise reject the four Marian dogmas.

Some elements that help us keep our Catholic Faith firm:

- Pray the Creed and read the Word of God
- Remember **that God is the creator of all things** (see Genesis Chapter 1 and 2 and Rom 1,20)
- Remember what Jesus said: **"I am the way, the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father except through Me."** (John 14,

Then he said to the disciple: "Here is your mother." And from this moment the disciple received her with him. (Jn 19, 26-27). In this act Our Lord gave his Blessed Mother to humanity and vice versa.

**fought only with an attitude of love or good vibes, but without actions of love or sacrifice for others, and they only proclaim the control of emotions and feelings by locking themselves in one same**

**Such ideas are totally contrary to the Gospel of Christ, since they deny that Jesus is the only Way, the Truth and the Life to reach God the Father (Jn 14, 6).**

**Unfortunately, many of these practices, little by little, open doors to energies or spiritual entities that do not come from God. Those who have had the opportunity to know about the One and Triune God should not be deceived by false prophets or spiritualities that do not come from Him (Mk 13, 22-23; Mt 24, 24-25). In the Catechism of the Catholic Church,**

**, numerals 675 and 676 is identified as an anti-Christian spirit, to all pseudo-messianism in which man glorifies himself, falling into an "intrinsically perverse" secularized messianism.**

**More new age examples: reiki, yoga, Zen, transcendental meditation, tantric exercises, sophrology, feng shui, tai-chi, ayurveda, mandalas; related personal improvement therapies, family constellations, personality enneagrams, mindfulness, courses in miracles and others.**

- In this document 3 interventions of St. John Paul II are mentioned. Here is one of them: The Holy Father has warned about the "renaissance of ancient Gnostic ideas in the form of the so-called New Age. We must not delude ourselves into thinking that this movement can lead to a renewal of religion. It is only a new way of practicing gnosis, that is, that posture of the spirit that, in the name of a profound knowledge of God, ends up distorting His Word, substituting it for words that are only human. Gnosis has never disappeared from the sphere of Christianity, but has always coexisted with it, sometimes in the form of philosophical currents, more often with religious or para-religious modalities, with a determined, although sometimes undeclared divergence with what it is essentially Christian.
- Psychology is used here to explain mind expansion as a "mystical" experience. Yoga, Zen, Transcendental Meditation, and Tantric exercises lead to an experience of self-fulfillment, or enlightenment. "Peak experiences" (reliving one's birth, traveling to death's door, biofeedback, dance, and even drugs, anything that can cause altered consciousness) are believed to lead to unity and the lighting. As there is only one Mind, some people can be channels or channels for higher beings. Every part of this one universal being is in contact with every other part. The classic approach of the New Age is transpersonal psychology, whose basic concepts are the Universal Mind, the Higher Self, the collective and personal unconscious and the individual ego. The Higher Self is our real identity, a bridge between God as divine Mind and humanity. Spiritual development consists in contact with the Higher Self, which overcomes all forms of dualism between subject and object, life and death, psyche and soma, the self and the fragmentary aspects of that same self. Our limited personality is like a shadow or a dream created by the real self. The "higher being" contains the memories of previous reincarnations (a concept that totally clashes with the Christian idea of Eternal Life in Christ)

**BY NAME, only the 3 Archangels revealed in the Bible can be invoked: Saint Michael in Dn 10, 13.21; Dan 12, 1; Jude 1, 9; Rev 12, 7. Saint Gabriel in Dn 9, 21; Lk 1, 19.26. And San Rafael in Tob 3, 25; Tob 8,3, Tob 12, 15. The other angels of heaven should only be invoked "without a name", in a generic way, such as the guardian angel and the angel of each nation.**

**Seraphim are mentioned in Is 6,2; Cherub in Ez 10; Thrones in Col 1,16; Dominations, Virtues and Powers and Principalities in Eph 1,21; Archangels in Judas 1,9 and Angels in many parts of the Bible.**

**The Guardian Angel is personal and concrete; but it should not be invoked by any name. See Mt 18,10; Lk 16,22; Acts 12.7**
